Hi all,

What an incredible start to the year we have had across the school. I am so proud of all of the children and specifically my phase, Year 2 and Year 3 (Ravens, Pigeons, Merlins and Nightingales) I have been lucky enough to be in all of their classrooms and have seen first hand how dedicated they have been to their learning.

There is a real buzz around school and a huge passion for learning. In the corridors, you can hear laughing and interesting conversations as the children discuss and develop their ideas.

In Maths, both year groups have been focusing on Place Value and thinking about how numbers are made. They have looked at using the Part Whole model, Tens Frames, Numicon, bead-strings amongst other resources. The children have worked hard to develop their Reasoning and Problem solving skills and have impressed us with their skills.

In English, both year groups have begun looking at their new English texts, "The Dark" in Year 2 and "The Journey" in Year 3. Both year groups are working hard to improve both their Reading and Writing skills and are enjoying expressing themselves.
