Mr Saxby and I have been out in school looking at our writing this morning and we wanted to say how amazing our Year 1 children are with their work. Their writing is so neat and accurate and we are so proud of them! It was great to have the chance to talk to the children about their work and to see their writing being displayed and celebrated! We are also really proud of Miss Rose who was nominated as 'Mentor of the Month' by Miss Spencer who is training to be a teacher. This is what she said about Miss Rose:

"Miss Rose has only recently come back from Maternity Leave and has taken over the role of my previous mentor. Not only is she a fantastic teacher for the class of children but she is a fantastic mentor who has made me feel extremely confident and supported as my teaching hours have increased this term. our teachers. They were really impressed with the quality of our early career teachers; the support that has been put in place for them now and in the future and the culture of the school. Special thanks to Mrs Rider for all her work in organising the programme in school and making sure our teachers are looked after and are having a good experience.

This week we have also taken the opportunity to thank our many amazing volunteers as part of volunteer appreciation week. Mrs Sheik, who coordinates our volunteer team, has organised for each person to be thanked, appreciated and celebrated with a special gift and a certificate. Every volunteer was really touched by this! We are really thankful for our wonderful volunteers so if you're on that team thank you for your support, you are greatly valued and appreciated!


Reminder - Increase for School Meals
