

Mobile Phones for Children Protocol

- Mobile phones should not be brought to school on the grounds that they are valuable and may be lost or stolen.
- We fully acknowledge a parent's right to allow their child to bring a mobile phone to school if they walk to and from school without adult supervision. If a child needs to bring a phone into school for this reason the permission slip attached to this policy must be completed by the parent. Please refer to the Policy on Safeguarding Children walking to and from school alone and note that pupils in year 4 and below should not walk alone.
- The phone must be turned off and handed in to the class teacher at the start of the day and collected at the end of the day. Phones should be clearly named to avoid any confusion.
- Where a pupil is found by a member of staff to be using a mobile phone or have an unapproved mobile phone in school, the phone will be confiscated from the pupil and handed to the class teacher. The teachers will label the phone with the child's name and hold it until the end of the day when the pupil must ask for it to be returned. A communication will be sent to parents requesting that a permission slip be returned the next day. If this practice continues more than three times, then the school will confiscate the phone until an appropriate adult collects the phone from a senior teacher.
- If a pupil is found taking photographs or video footage with a mobile phone of either other pupils or teachers, this will be regarded as a serious offence and disciplinary action will be taken according to our Behaviour Policy.
- Should a pupil be found to be using their phone inappropriately, the school reserves the right to withdraw this privilege and they will no longer be able to bring a phone into school.
- Parents are advised that Little Paxton Primary School accepts no liability for the loss or damage to mobile phones which are brought into school or school grounds.
- Should parents need to contact pupils or vice versa during the school day, this should be done via the usual school procedure of contacting the school office via phone or email.

This protocol will be monitored and reviewed as required but at least every two years.

- Your child needs to hand in their phone to their class teacher first thing in the morning.

- Your child's phone should be appropriately named so that it can be returned.
- Should your child be found using their phone inappropriately, the school reserves the right to withdraw this privilege and they will no longer be able to bring their phone into school.
