Year 1 begin this term by practising their handwriting and remembering their nonnegotiables (capital letters, finger spaces and full stops!). In year 2 the children will be doing a 'place value grammar' unit which will help them understand the correct names for different nouns and verbs. It will then help shape their writing for the test of the year

Maths

CANCEL STATE

In Year 1 the children will begin the year learning about place value. They will be focusing on securing their knowledge of numbers and learning to count on. In Year 2 the children will be learning about place value and addition and subtraction.

Music/Art

In Music the children have been improvising rhythms and composing call and response music. They will be playing a melody with a tuned percussion instrument and focusing on language-pitch, structure, tempo, timbre.

Science

In Science we will be exploring everyday objects. We will be investigating different properties of materials and identifying if objects can sink or float. We have also been looking at how we can change the shape of the material with force.

History

This term Year 1 and 2 will be learning about Neil Armstrong, Apollo 11, the space race and how it lands. We will be discussing the impact of how the first photograph of the landing on the moon has influenced how we should be looking after our planet.

Our PE sessions will be on a Monday afternoon and Thursday Morning. Please ensure that children wear full PE kit and NO jewellery. They will be exploring Fundamentals and focussing on agility, balancing and coordination. On Thursday morning, we currently have a Cymnastics coach.
