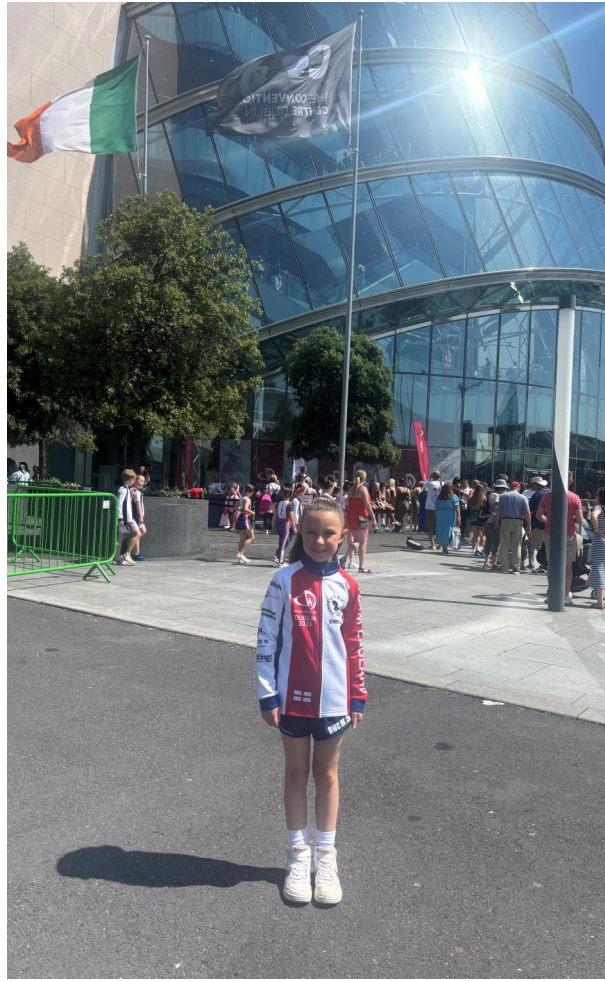


Emilia, Melodie, Ariella & Phoebe
